# **COMMUNITY REMINDERS**

## **COMMUNITY WINTER REMINDERS**

### Here are some important reminders for periods of freezing temperatures this Winter:

- Protect Pipes and Plumbing: To prevent pipes from freezing, open cabinet doors under sinks, especially those along exterior walls. Let faucets drip to keep water moving and reduce the risk of freezing.
- Outdoor Faucets and Hoses: Disconnect and drain any garden hoses from outdoor faucets. If possible, cover outdoor faucets with a towel to protect them from freezing.
- Space Heaters: If you use space heaters, make sure they are not near flammable objects and always turn them off when leaving a room or going to sleep.
- Heating Systems: Set your thermostat no lower than 65 degrees. Even if you are Planning on going out of town or leaving your home for more than 24 hours, it is imperative to leave the heat running to help prevent your pipes from freezing and bursting.
- Room Registers: Make sure registers are not obstructed and leave them open even in unused rooms.

## **SAFETY TIPS**

### We love seeing your holiday lights!

Every year, holiday lights should be tested for safety prior to use. If you choose to purchase new lights this year, look for a label indicating that the lights were independently tested for safety. Whether they are new or old, inspect each set of lights for broken or cracked sockets, frayed or bare wires, or loose connections. As a reminder: For your safety, please remember that placing lights on the second story or roof of your home is not allowed.
