

COMMUNITY REMINDERS

COMMUNITY REMINDERS

To maintain a pleasant living environment for all residents, we kindly request your cooperation in adhering to the following community guidelines:

- Pet Waste: Please promptly pick up after your pet and dispose of it in designated areas. Pet stations have been strategically placed throughout our communities for easy disposal.
- Property Maintenance: Keep your immediate surroundings and common areas free of debris
 and clutter. Toys should be brought indoors when not in use and never left in shared spaces.
 Trash cans should be stored next to your home after trash collection and not left curbside.
- Home Modifications: Any modifications to your home, including the installation of security cameras, require prior approval from the community center. When installing items (cameras/decorations) to your home, please avoid drilling, screwing, or nailing into the exterior.
- Parking Restrictions: Please refrain from parking on the grass. Please park with the flow of traffic.
- Please be sure to remove all holiday decorations not later than January 12th.

MAINTENANCE & SAFETY REMINDERS

Here are some important reminders for periods of freezing temperatures this Winter:

- Protect Pipes and Plumbing: To prevent pipes from freezing, open cabinet doors under sinks, especially those along exterior walls. Let faucets drip to keep water moving and reduce the risk of freezing.
- Outdoor Faucets and Hoses: Disconnect and drain any garden hoses from outdoor faucets. If possible, cover outdoor faucets with a towel to protect them from freezing.
- Space Heaters: If you use space heaters, make sure they are not near flammable objects and always turn them off when leaving a room or going to sleep.
- If traveling during the winter months, please be sure to let your community team know prior to leaving, set your thermostat to no lower than 65 degrees and make sure room registers are not obstructed or closed.
